## Who we are

**The Glebe Community Association (GCA)** is a voluntary, non-profit, membership-based and City-recognized organization advocating for a liveable, sustainable, diverse urban neighbourhood.

The GCA informs, consults and engages with residents and other groups in the Glebe on issues of importance and promotes the interests of our community with all levels of government and other organizations.

We work with:

## What we do

- Organize the **Great Glebe Garage Sale**, raising almost \$250,000 for the Food Bank since the sale began in 1986
- **Host public meetings** at election time and on municipal and local issues. Our board meetings, on the 4th Tuesday of the month at 7 p.m. at the Glebe Community Centre, are open to the public.
- Apply for grants for projects that support the **environment** and **streetside parklets**
- Provide fora to discuss **education, environmental, health and social, heritage, planning, parks, tenant, transportation** and other issues affecting Glebe residents
- Encourage activities, like tree planting and educational fora, to protect the **environment**
- Promote restoration and **heritage designation** to protect properties and areas
- Through activities such as **Imagine Glebe** consult residents and comment on planning initiatives and development applications
- Promote maintenance of our local **parks**
- Respond to and advise the City on **pedestrian, cycling, transportation and parking** issues affecting our neighbourhood.
- **Voice** local concerns you may raise.
